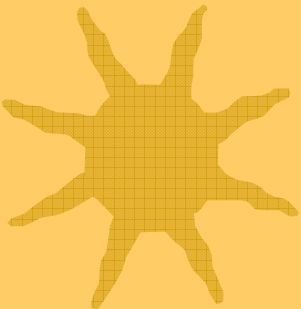
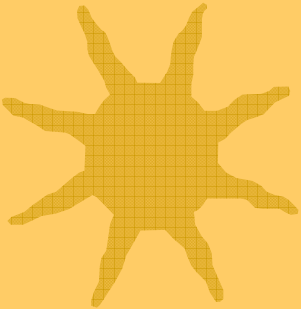
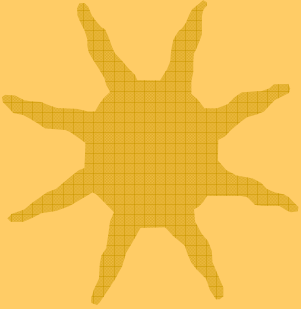




Unmet Needs continued

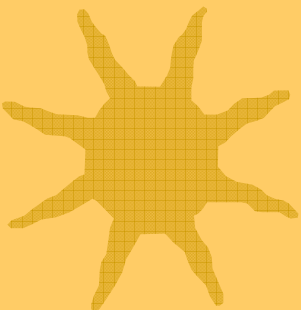
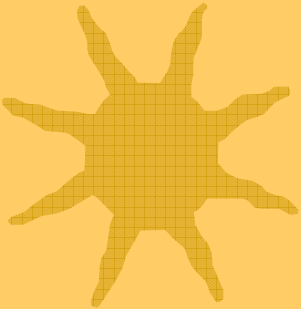
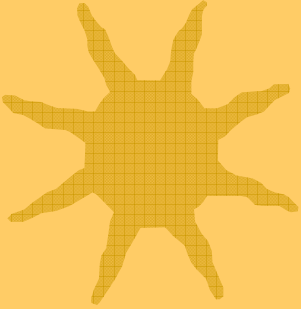
★ Health Care

- Stigmatization in Primary Care Facilities





Suggestions for Meeting Needs



- ★ Funding should be introduced to support transgender primary care within CBOs
 - Programs already established for transgender communities could incorporate primary care
 - Transgender clients more likely to utilize services in safe and familiar environments
 - There currently exists a severe lack of funding for primary care within CBOs for HIV-negative, but at-risk clients
